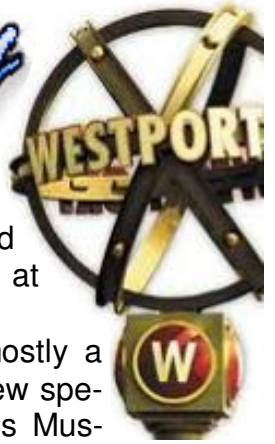


Wheels in Motion Day
