



On a cold but sunny February 16th, our club toured the Soldiers Memorial Museum in St. Louis. The recently refurbished facility went through a 30 million dollar renovation. The Soldiers Memorial Military Museum is a memorial and military museum located at 1315 Chestnut Street, owned by the City of St. Louis and operated by the Missouri Historical Society. Interior east and west wings contain display cases with military displays and memorabilia from World War I and subsequent American wars.
